

# ECO funding for Sheffield City Council District Heating replacement works

## Client's objectives

Sheffield Council's objective was to maintain the smooth and efficient running of heating systems across residential housing estates.

## The project

The Council provide a low carbon heat source for the large residential Pedley Estate through its District Heating scheme. Anthesis was required to source funding to replace the heating system boilers.

## Key services delivered

- Anthesis arranged SAP surveys at residents' properties to determine their energy performance and calculate the level of carbon savings the upgrades would achieve
- This allowed us to determine the Council's eligibility for funding
- We accessed Energy Company Obligation (ECO) funding using our unique Ofgem approved methodology
- We completed the funding application and associated requirements

## Project impacts

- Sheffield City Council were awarded over £100,000 in funding
- The Council were able to continue their heating system replacement work
- Residents benefited from more reliable and efficient heating and hot water
